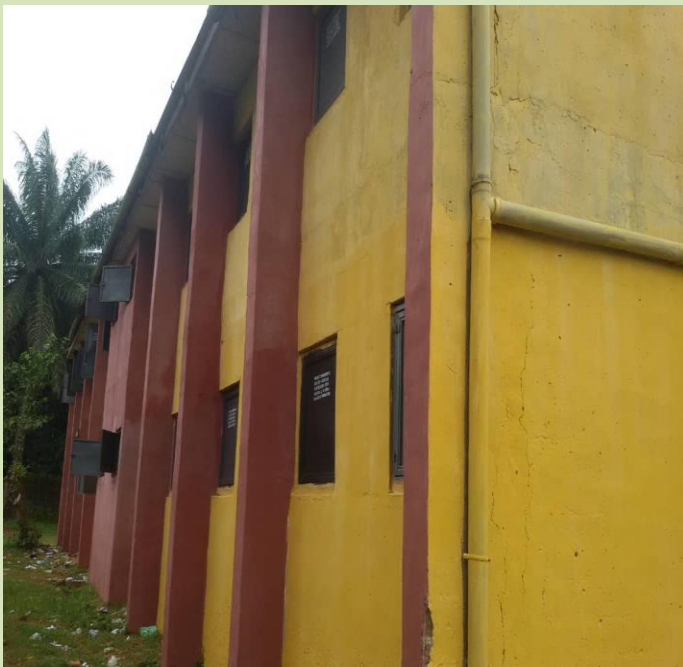

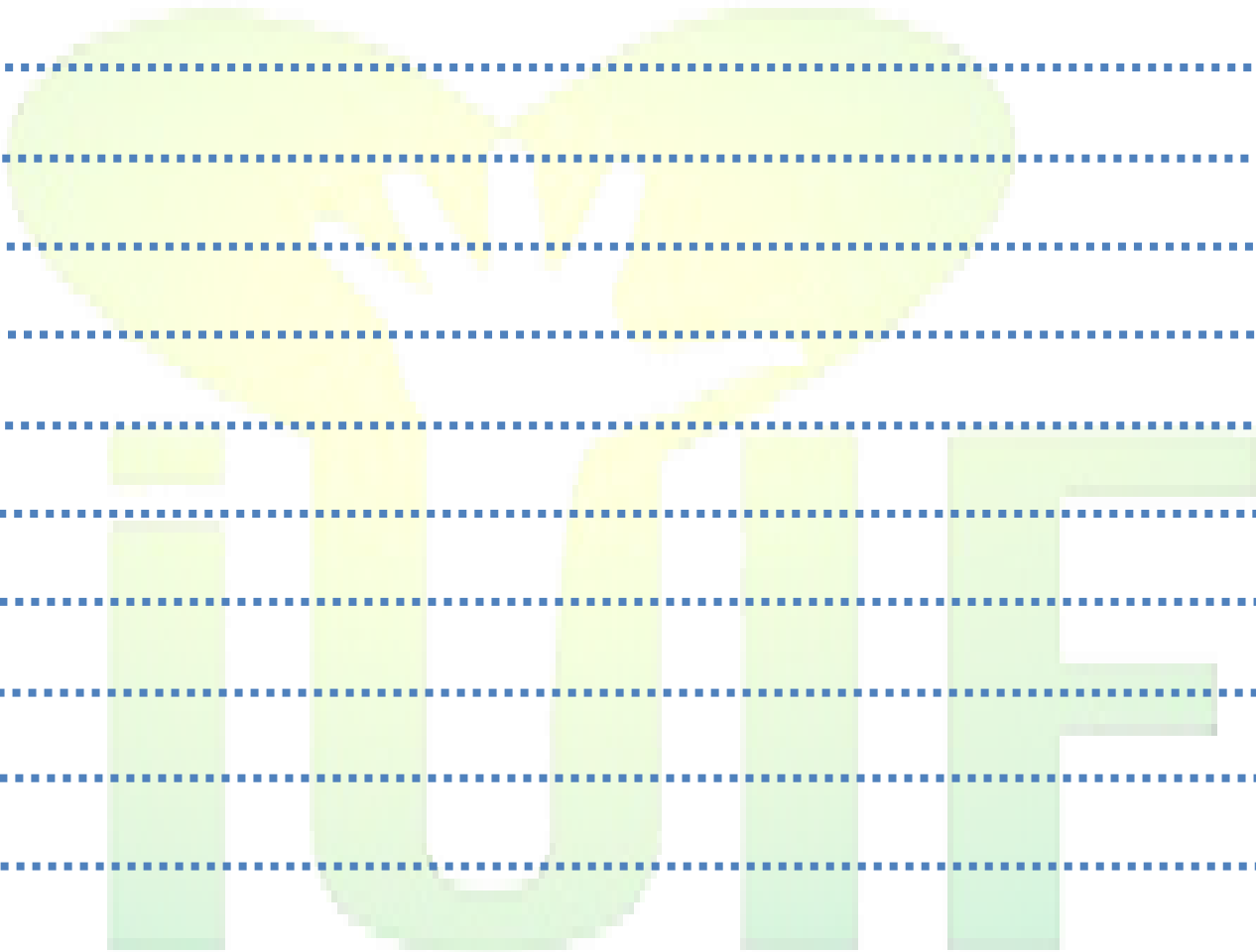

REFURBISHING OF A COMMUNITY SCHOOL IN ISUOFIA

Re-floored 4 classrooms and respective corridors of an abandoned wing of the school. Classes was stopped in this section of the building due to the dilapidated state of the classroom block. A toilet facility was also built for their staff."



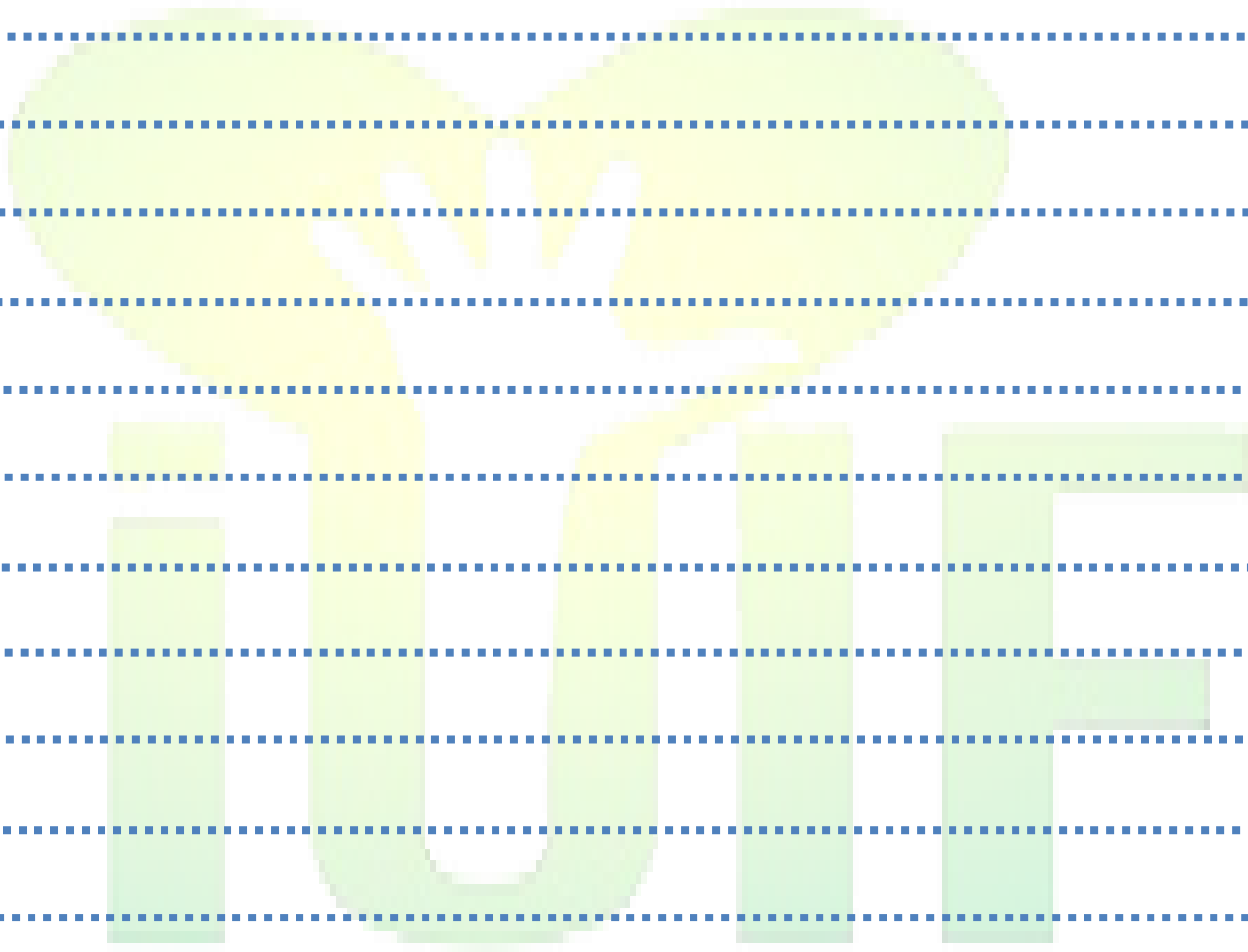
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ESTABLISHMENT OF A MAKESHIFT SCHOOL IN UMUIFITE

- Lunch boxes/baskets”



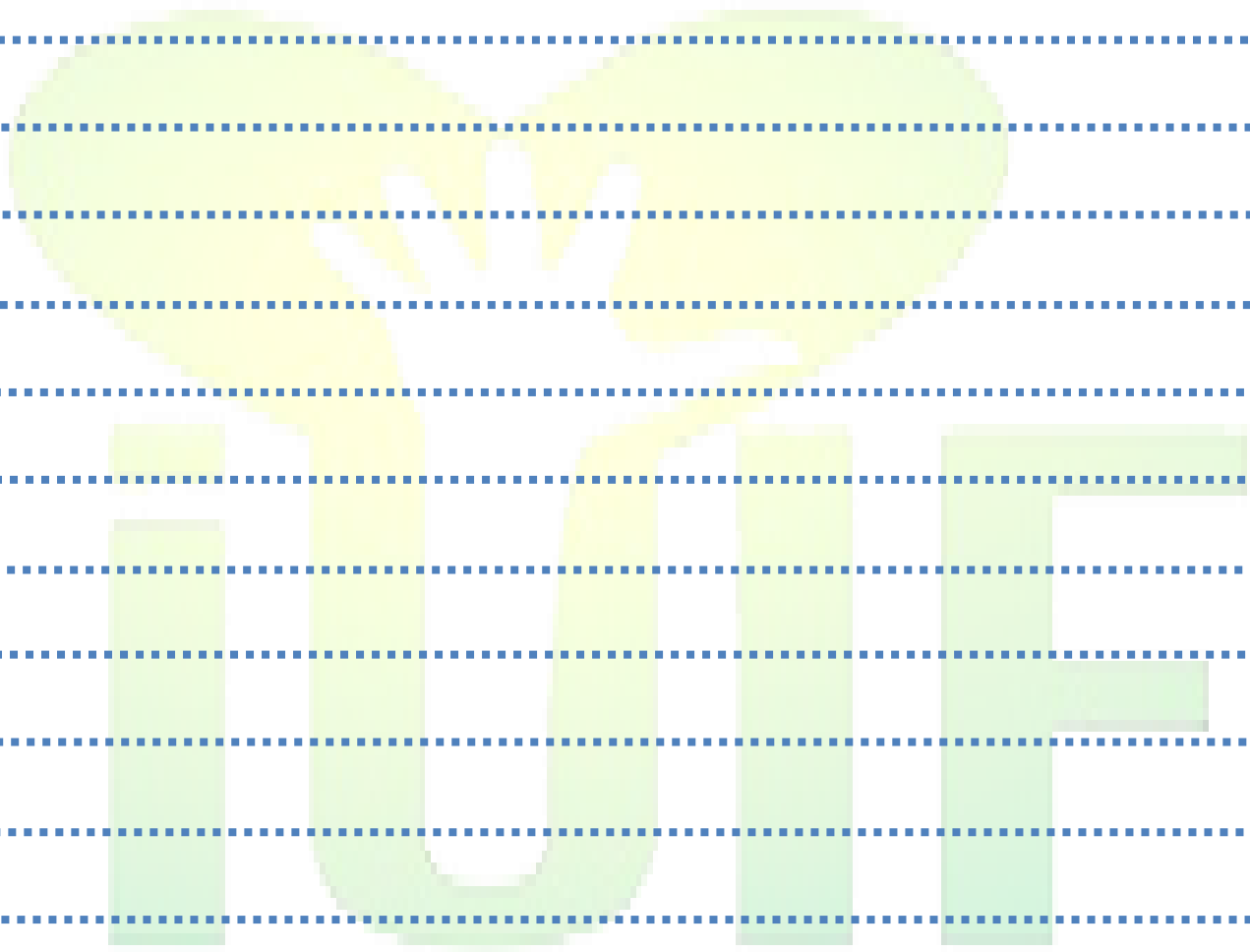
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FIVE PUPILS WERE ALSO SUPPORTED IN BAKIN KASUWA PRIMARY SCHOOL, SOKOTO

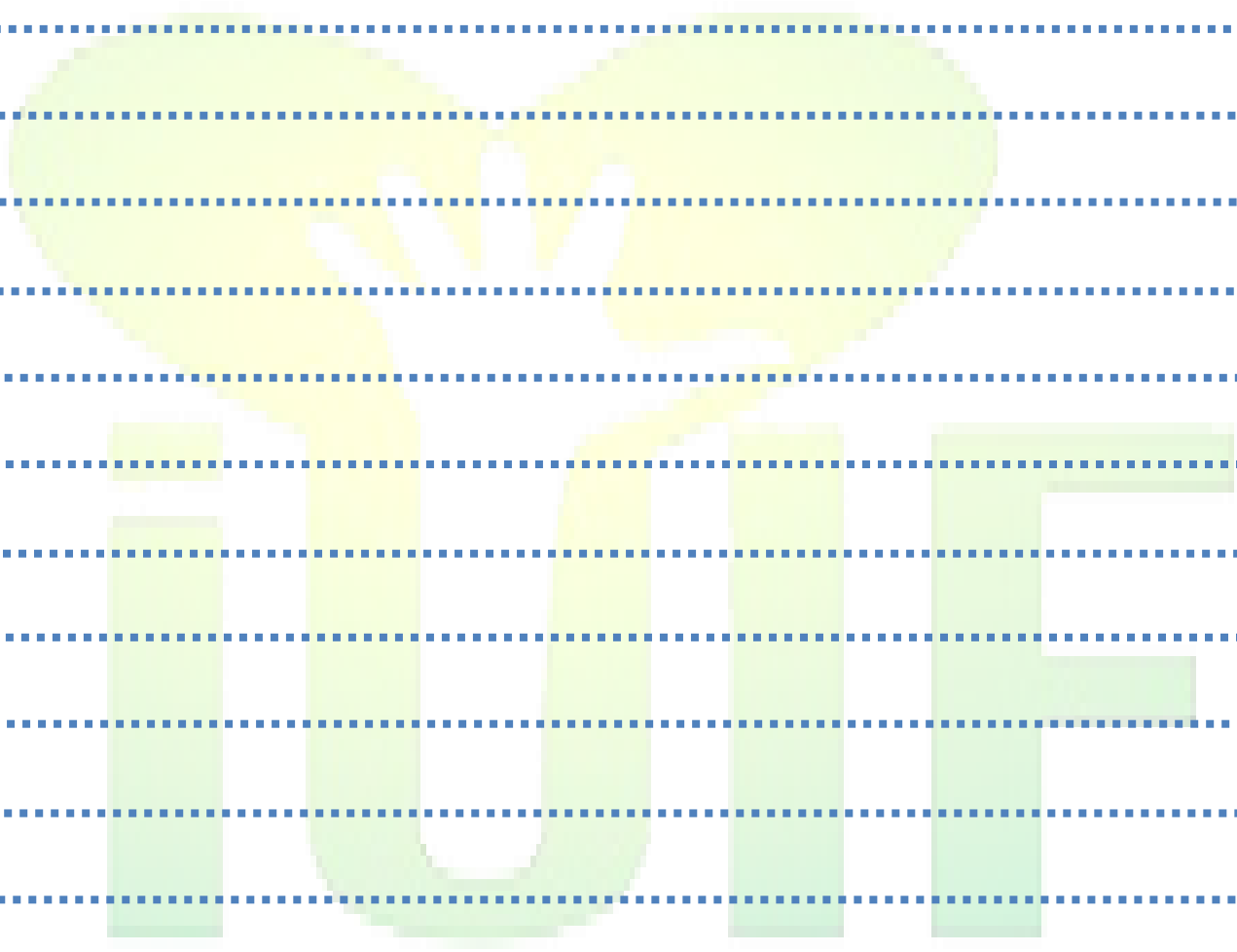


REVIVING HEALTHCARE FACILITIES IN ANAOCHA, NIGERIA

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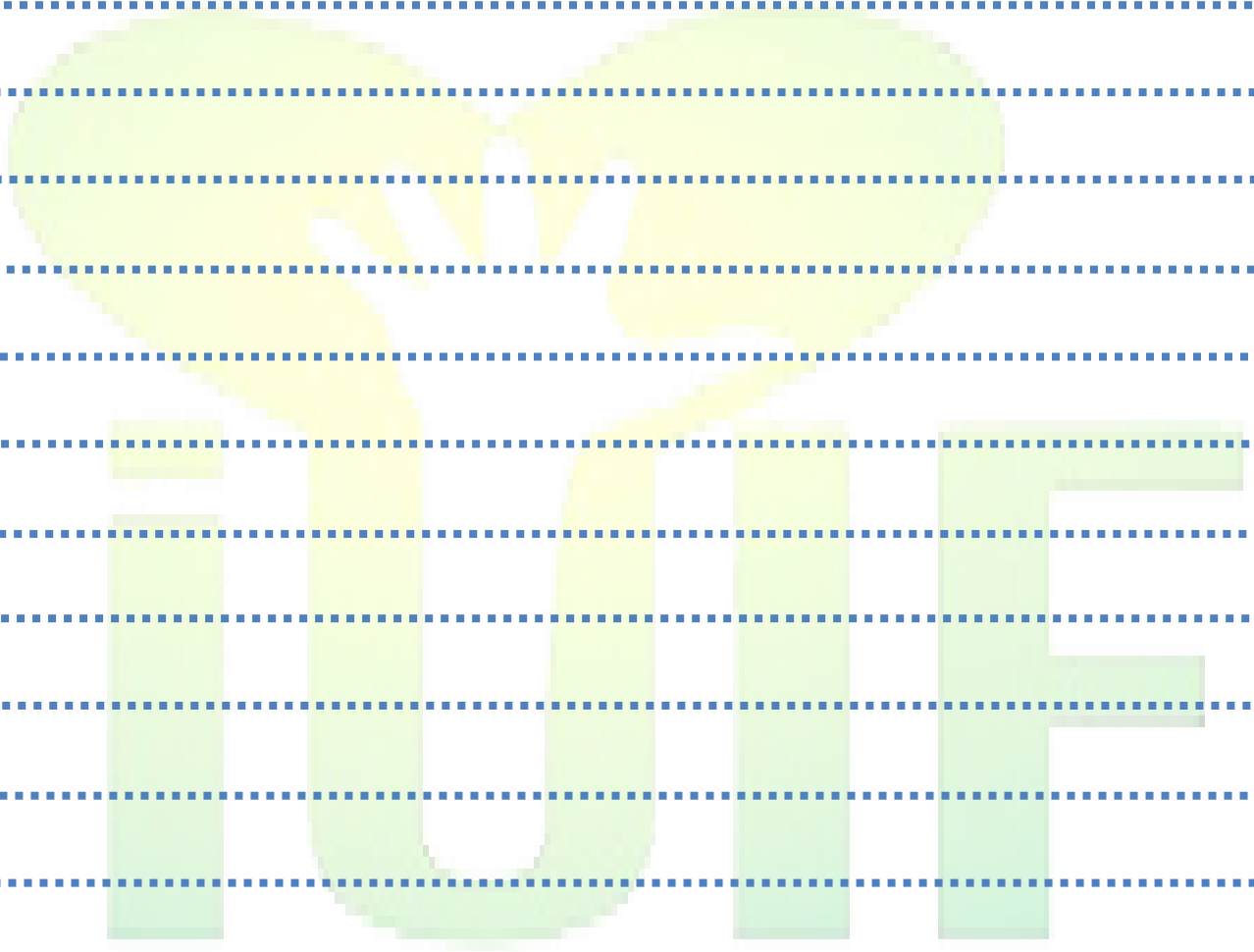


REFURBISHING THE RUN DOWN NNEOGIDI HEALTHCARE CENTER

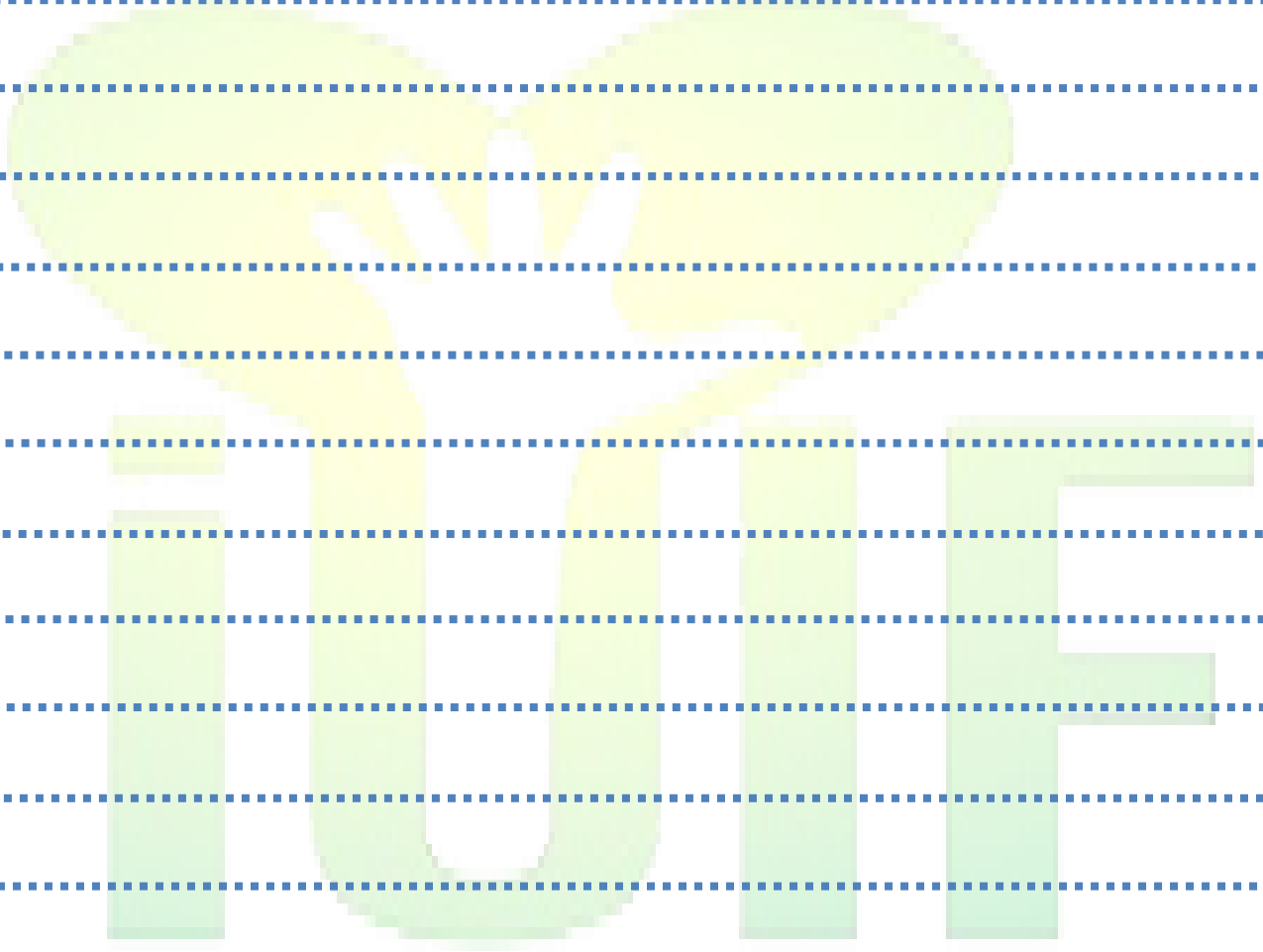

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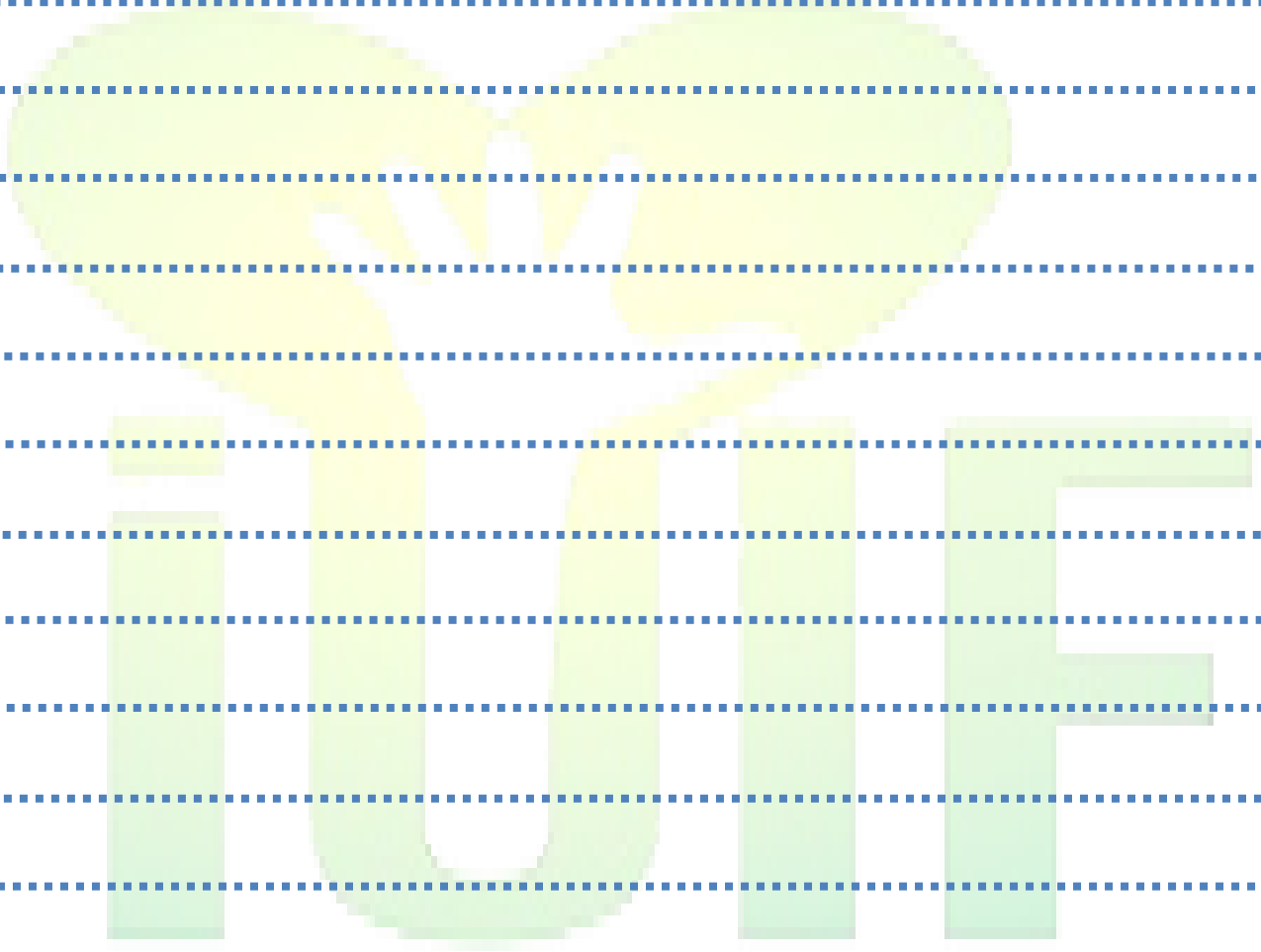
PROJECT COMMISSIONING OF THE UNION SECONDARY SCHOOL AGULU
